

Client/Server Message System v3.28

Release Note

1 Current Release

This release supersedes the 3.27 release of the Client/Server Messaging System from Connection Software. Note that version 3.24 was never publicly released, whilst versions 3.25 and 3.26 were limited test releases only.

1.1 Issues dealt with in this release

Issue Number	Type	Description
2151	CR	The Send and Clear buttons have been relocated and resized. This is to prevent pressing the Clear button when the Send button was intended and vice-versa.
2202 / 2196	BF	The application could stop sending messages with no warning and no error messages. This was incorrectly believed to be associated with drop-files but was actually caused by failed route deletion operations on the Database that left orphan routes around. Although a warning was given, it was very vague. The deletion works correctly now. Should it ever fail, a clear and understandable error message is displayed.
2153	BF	The system would sometimes report the vague error 'Error Reading File: <filename>: Cause 11'. This is a actually warning that a drop-file that was to be read was actually locked. It can occur in day-to-day operation and usually means that the drop-file authoring application has not finished writing to the file when the Messaging Server tried to read it. The Messaging Server will simply move over that file and retry it again the next time. Continual reports of this nature would suggest a more serious system error, however occasional reports are normal. The message has been changed to a warning and an English explanation of the cause number is given instead.
2155	BF	The Sending Messages configuration dialog now includes descriptive text of all the entries including the units they are measured in.
1863	CR	When selecting names from the Address book, if the name is typed in, and exists in the list, it is scrolled into view, if not already so. The list box has been resized so that when the entry is scrolled into view at the end of the list box, it is fully displayed.
2217	BF	At start-up the Server now reports two warnings regarding the possible mis-configuration of the Infolink Receiver will full details of what to do depending on whether there is actually a Receiver attached to the system. Previously these were regarded as System Errors.
1843	BF	The Connection Software telephone number is correct.
1873	BF	Changing the destination Id for a contact in the Contact Properties dialog box is recognised and updated.
2199	BF	There are no memory leaks in the Client when the Server shuts down or when it fails to connect to the Server.
2218	CR	The client is supported under Windows 2000. <i>The server is not.</i>
2215	BF	The help files are clear, accurate, and up-to-date.
